A Bill to Provide Election Assistance

Be it enacted by the Student Senate of George Mason University,

That up to \$2000 is appropriated for providing monetary assistance to campaigns in the 2012 Spring General Election. The following regulations shall apply:

- 1) Executive tickets may reimburse up to \$100 and Senate candidates may reimburse up to \$50 in costs associated with campaigning;
- 2) The money shall be available on a first come, first serve basis;
- 3) When \$250 remains, campaigns who show financial need shall receive priority;
- 4) This money shall not be considered an endorsement by Student Government; and
- 5) Campaigns using these funds must abide by all regulations set by the Student Government Advisor.
