A Bill to Allocate Funds for Gold Rush T-Shirts

Be it enacted by the Student Senate of George Mason University,

That a total of \$11,221.75 is allocated for Student Government's participation towards
Gold Rush of which:

- A) \$8,572.25 is allocated for 2,535 adult shirts of which:
 - 1. \$2,412 is allocated for 720 Small shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 2. \$2,680 is allocated for 800 Medium shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 3. \$2127.25 is allocated for 635 Large shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 4. \$1,005 is allocated for 300 Extra Large shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
and
 - 5. \$348 is allocated for 80 Extra Extra Large shirts (at a rate of \$4.35 per shirt).
- B) \$xxx.xx is allocated for 250 children shirts of which:
 - 1. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 50 Small shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 2. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 50 Medium shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 3. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 50 Large shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 4. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 50 Extra Large shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
and
 - 5. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 50 Extra Extra Large shirts (at a rate of \$4.35 per shirt).
- C) \$1000 is allocated for 500 shirts for alumni of which:
 - 1. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 120 Small shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 2. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 140 Medium shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
 - 3. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 100 Large shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);

4. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 80 Extra Large shirts (at a rate of \$3.35 per shirt);
and
5. \$xxx.xx is allocated for 60 Extra Extra Large shirts (at a rate of \$4.35 per shirt).

D) The money allocated for Section A shall be offset by donations from various offices and organization. For example, the \$1000 donation from Athletics, the \$250 donation from ADHE, etc. The money allocated for Section B and C shall be paid for in its entirety by donations from the Office of Family Programs and Services, Weekends at Mason, and the Office of Alumni Affairs.
