Whereas, 3,711 freshman students were admitted for the Fall 2018 semester and George Mason University has seen an incline of 500 freshman students accepted since the Fall 2016 census with a total enrollment of 24,987 undergraduate students, and;

Whereas, George Mason University has only 6,200 beds available as of January 28th of 2019, and;

Whereas, there is a need for upperclassmen students to understand where to look for off campus housing, what to look for in a lease, and what is a healthy landlord to tenant relationship.

Therefore, be it resolved, that George Mason Student Government recognizes the necessity to support an off-campus housing accessibility awareness campaign to connect students with the necessary off campus housing resources (ie advisors, appropriate websites, checklists) during the 2019 Spring Semester.
